### CALL FOR ENTRIES

#### ELIGIBILITY

Any member of the Mid-Atlantic Chapter (MAC) of IIDA is eligible to enter local, regional, national, and international interior design projects completed after 01 January 2008. The submitting IIDA member is to have been the primary designer of the project. Members and their firms are allowed to submit a maximum of five entries: no more than three entries may be submitted in one category.

#### PROJECT REGISTRATION

Each project must be registered with the MAC Design Awards Committee no later than, 8 January 2010. To register a project each must be accompanied by: 1) the attached Registration Form, 2) an entry fee in the form of a check payable to IIDA Mid-Atlantic Chapter for \$85.00 per entry, and 3) the e-mail address of the entering firm's contact. Upon receipt of these, an entry package and a registration number for each entry will be mailed or e-mailed promptly.

#### ENTRY FORMS SUBMITTAL DEADLINE

All entries must be received by the MAC Design Awards Committee no later than 5:00 PM, 12 February 2010. Delivery instructions and all forms will be included in the entry package.

#### CATEGORIES

For each entry, identify a category from the following:

- Commercial under 20,000 square feet
- Commercial between 20,000 and 100,000 square feet
- Commercial over 100,000 square feet
- Educational/Institutional
- Healthcare
- Hospitality
- Residential
- Local/State/Federal Governments
- Retail
- Special Merit Award for Sustainable Design\*

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To maintain anonymity, the names of entrants or firms must not appear on any part of the project graphics. Failure to comply with all of the requirements may result in the rejection of the submission. The following must be included with each entry:

#### DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS

A CD with a minimum of three – but no more than twelve – jpeg images of the project (Tiff files will not be accepted). The file name of all jpegs must include the project's registration number and the sequence number in which the image should be viewed. In a text file, associate each file name with that of the photographer. CDs will not be returned. Printed copies of photos are not needed.

#### FLOOR PLAN

A jpeg(s) of the floor plan(s) with which the images are associated.

#### PROJECT INFORMATION FORM

A completed Project Information Form, which is strictly limited to 500 words or fewer. The text may be cross-referenced to the presentation sequence of the jpeg images.

#### CLIENT REFERENCE FORM

A Client Reference Form.

### JUDGING AND AWARDS

Certificates entitled Gold Award, Silver Award, Bronze Award, or Special Merit Award for Sustainable Design may be awarded. One, multiples or none of these may be awarded in each category. From among the Gold Award recipients, one will be selected to receive the year's top honor: The Pinnacle Award, accompanied by a certificate and a trophy. The judging will occur in March 2010. The honors will be announced and presented at THE PREMIERE in April 2010 in Washington, DC. At that time, the names of the judges will be disclosed.

\*Only LEED certified projects are eligible for the sustainable design category. If a project has certification pending at the time of the award, it must be demonstrated that a project has been registered with the USGBC and at minimum that the Design Review has been completed.
